ARTIST STATEMENT

In my work, I am interested in revealing structures of consciousness as experienced from the first-person point of view. These experiences are reflected in my work in the fragile point between non-narrative fragments; and a coherent composition. The construction of the works is exposed and the formation is displayed as an integral part of the work, therefore some of my inspiration comes from observing how the nature and logic of forms can



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serve a certain role or a purpose - functionality. I use materials such as metal, charcoal and graphite in their raw state and attempt to keep them that way until the final stage, seeking to preserve their brutal, rough, direct traits. *“...the philosophy which is so important in each of us is not a technical matter; it is our more or less dumb sense of what life honestly and deeply means.
